The Sathya Sai Baba Organization of America, Pacific South Region 8 held its 5th Annual Huntington Park Medical Camp on July 10, 2016 at St. Martha Catholic Church, Huntington Park, CA. The camp provided free screening for primary care, blood lab, vision, dental, women's health, patient education and insurance. Patients with needs that were beyond the scope of the camp, were referred to a local clinics offering discounts. Patients were also provided with free lunch and free grocery bags.

The camp started at 7:30 am with patients registering and designating which services they wish to obtain. Patients then were led by volunteers to each area of service requested.

Our non-medical volunteers included the following:

Our medical volunteers included the following:

- ❖ 3 Optometrists
- ❖ 2 Ophthalmologist
- ❖ 6 Dentist
- ❖ 3 Primary Care Doctors
- ❖ 8 Nurses from Avanti Community Hospital
- ❖ 3 Medical Assistants from AltaMed Clinic
- ❖ 5 Other Medical professionals

A total of 425 men, women, and children registered for the medical camp.

- ❖ Vision – 400
- ❖ Dental – 130
- ❖ Women Care – 50 (39 Mammogram and 11 Pap Smears)
- ❖ Primary Care and Blood Lab – 191 (100 – Avanti and 91 - AltaMed)
- ❖ Patient Education and Insurance – 60 (Dietician – 28; Diabetic Association – 16, Insurance – 16)

➤ Of the 400 Vision patients, 9 needed no prescription, 9 need to be made at the optical lab and 382 received recycled eyeglasses (102 patients examined were receiving eyeglasses for the first time)

- ✓ 3 patients need an excision of a pterygium on at least one eye.
- ✓ 1 patient needs a penetrating keratoplasty for a dense corneal scar.
- ✓ 1 patient needs a work up for possible plaquenil toxicity.
- ✓ 5 patients need cataract surgery on at least on eye.

- ✓ 4 patients need assessment / treatment for glaucoma.
- ✓ 3 patients need a 6 month follow up for background diabetic retinopathy.
- ✓ 1 patient needs laser surgery for a secondary cataract.
- ✓ 1 patient received life style advice for dry macular degeneration.
- ✓ 1 patient needs assessment / treatment for an epi-retinal membrane.
